



Great Outdoors Annual Conference & Jamboree

“San Clemente State Beach”

October 20th, 21st and 22nd 2006

The Orange County/Long Beach chapter of California Great Outdoors, Inc. is proud to host this year's all-chapter Conference & Jamboree in San Clemente California. This event will be held at San Clemente State Beach, which is a tree lined park on the bluffs overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

The theme of this year's outing will be 'October Fest', including a traditional German meal! This important conference and jamboree not only includes fun and sun, but also provides a venue for annual elections of the following three Corporate officers (any member in good standing can run for these offices – why don't you?):

- Chair – Responsibilities include overseeing the corporate organization, appointing board committee chairpersons, organizing quarterly board meetings, and approving financial records.
- Financial Officer – Responsibilities include overseeing the corporate financial records, ensuring accurate and timely financial reporting by chapters, submit annual records to IRS (as a non-profit org), and generating chapter and corporate financial reports
- Secretary – Responsibilities include ensuring quorums at quarterly board meetings and annual elections, recording meeting minutes, and reporting resulting action items

On Friday night we will have a gathering for refreshments, to include snacks, beverages (with wine), cheeses and fresh fruit. Our Outgoing Board Meeting will be held Fri 8:30pm. We will serve breakfast on Saturday morning, followed by our Annual Elections and Incoming Board Meeting starting at . The highlight of the day will be a traditional German meal for dinner on Saturday night, so bring your favorite stout beer or German wine to enjoy with your meal.

We have fourteen camping spaces for mixed use, for tent camping and RV's shorter than 24 feet in length, and two full hook-up RV sites. The full hook-up sites are about 200 feet from the mixed use sites. The mixed use sites are all adjacent to each other. Each site has running water, fire rings/BBQ's or a BBQ, picnic table and a shaded cover. There are flush toilets, hot showers (requiring quarters), all road ways are paved. The beach is about a quarter of a mile away, down a short bluff. We will also have the amphitheater for our meetings and an evening of entertainment.

The city of San Clemente is a wonderful place to stroll about, checking the antique stores and specialty shops. The pier at the beach is a popular spot with all the locals, plus endless miles of clean sands to walk, on a fantastic California sunny day. We will organize a trip to San Onofre State park, to do a day hike up through the Coastal Canyon of Orange County.

We will start arriving on Friday afternoon, 2:00 pm or later, Set-up your site and enjoy the weekend. Friday evening will have the refreshments about 7:00 pm (snacks, wine and cheese, fresh fruits and beverages). And of course a camp fire or two. Bring one bundle of fire wood.

Saturday morning, breakfast will be served at 8:00 am. The day hike should proceed at 9:30 am. There are Volley ball courts on the beach (these are very heavily used). The rest of the day will be set up as required for trips and the corporate meetings.

Dinner is at 6:00 pm, bring your favorite German beer, wine or beverage to accompany the traditional German

feast. The amphitheater will be used for entertainment after the evening feast, and there will be a campfire.

Break camp on Sunday morning. Not later than 12noon.

The cost are as follows.

Tent camping: \$45.00 per member, \$55.00 per non-member.

RV's up to 24 feet (no hookups) members is \$80.00, non-member cost is \$90.00 with one person, each additional person in the RV is \$20.00 (a travel trailer and two vehicle is counted as one vehicle with no parking fees).

RV's full hookups \$110.00 with one person, non-member cost is \$125.00. Each additional person in the RV is \$20.00,(includes parking fees for one tow vehicle).

Day trippers, \$20.00 (includes breakfast and dinner on Saturday).

All camping fees include Friday nights refreshment gathering, Saturday morning breakfast and theFriday night Feast.

Due to the increased cost for the park systems a \$10.00 per day, per vehicle parking fee has been instituted and must be paid at the gate to the State Park. Parking fees apply to the tent campers and day trippers. We will adjust all camping fees as needed if we need to have tent campers and Rv'ers share any sites. Carpooling will reduce your parking fees.

From Ventura / Santa Barbara take the 101 south to the LA area, continue on the 101 through LA until it connects with the I5 south or pick up the 405 south to the interstate 5 then south to the above directions.

From the inland empire take interstate 15 south to State Route 76 (to Oceanside) west. Take Interstate 5 north to San Clemente , to Avenida Calafia, follow the signs.
