Our Campsite

We've reserved the spacious Lobo Group Campground in the Barton Flats area of the San Bernardino Mountains. Set among oak and pines, our site sits at 6,500 feet above sea level. It boasts picnic tables, potable water, fire pits and restrooms. Leashed dogs are allowed at the campsite, but may not be invited on all hikes. Expect pleasant sunny days and cool nights, and a possibility of afternoon thundershowers. You may check in Friday any time after 3PM.

What to Bring

You'll need the usual clothing and camping gear for a weekend in the mountains. Bring your tent, tarp, sleeping bag and pad, food, cooler, stove and fuel, lantern, and if you have one, a solar shower. For day hikes, pack boots, a knapsack, water bottle, bug repellent and a flashlight.

Getting There

From Los Angeles head east on the 10. In the city of Redlands, exit on Alabama to Lugonio Ave (State Hwy 38). Follow the 38 for about 25 miles to Barton Flats, and look for the entrance to the Lobo Group Campground on the left.

Activities

Friday 8/27/10 – Check in anytime after 3PM. Dinner is on your own. Get acquainted campfire and board games after sunset.

Saturday 8/28/10 Select a day hike the best suits your interests and skill level

8:30AM – This is a moderate 8-mile (roundtrip) hike to John's Meadow. (no dogs)

9:30AM - A relatively easy 3-mile (roundtrip) hike to Horse Meadow

10:30AM- Other activities might include a walk to nearby Jenks Lake

7:00PM - Our traditional potluck free-for-all. Bring a dish to share. GO will provide the plates/cutlery and desert. Join us for an after dinner campfire, raffle and board games.

Sunday - Enjoy a leisurely morning; check out at 1PM.

We can't guarantee you a ride to this campsite, but will use your registration form to assemble a rideshare list which will be emailed to those registered seeking or offering a ride.
